Rob Bradley of Hendrix College is the winner of the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference 1985 Cliff Shaw Scholar-Athlete Award.

Bradley was a three year letterman for the Hendrix swimming team, graduating in June with a 3.93 grade point average.

He was named NAIA All American after the 1985 NAIA National Swimming and Diving Championship Meet in Indianapolis, Indiana. He had the highest grade point average of any athlete competing in the NAIA National Championship Meet, and scored in the 400 and 800 yard freestyle relay events.
