James "TE" Howard of Harding University is the winner of the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference 1989 Cliff Shaw Scholar-Athlete Award.

Howard, a four-year letterman on the Bison track and field squad, graduated *summa cum laude* in May with a Bachelor of Arts degree in physical education. He achieved a perfect 4.00 grade point average on 148 hours of college work.

In 1988, Howard received the NAIA prestigious A. O. Duer Award, presented annually to the nation's top junior scholar-athlete. He is the only Harding athlete to be selected as a first team GTE/CoSIDA College Division All-American. He was named to the at-large team in 1988, and earned second team honors in 1987.
