David Allen Harmon of Southern Arkansas University is the winner of the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference 1986 Cliff Shaw Scholar-Athlete Award.

Harmon, who lettered three years in baseball at Southern Arkansas University, graduated summa cum laude from SAU in May. He accumulated a 3.96 grade point average while majoring in biology and minoring in Chemistry. He was a member of Alpha Chi National Scholastic Honor Society, SAU Student Foundation, and the Biology Club. He was also selected as SAU's Scholar-Athlete Award winner for being the school's outstanding male scholar-athlete.
