1974 WINNER

Jamie M. Cowley, Harding College basketball player, is the 1974 winner of the AIC's Cliff Shaw-Scholar Athlete Award.

A social science major, Cowley graduated MAGNA CUM LAUDE this spring from Harding with a cumulative grade point of 3.844 and 128 semester hours. He was a member of Kappa Sigma Kappa social club and served four years as treasurer. He was elected to membership in Pi Alpha Pheta national honorary fraternity as a junior, and he was elected this year to Alpha Chi, a national college honor scholarship society. He is married to the former Vickie Sue Pace of North Little Rock, a junior elementary education major at Harding College. He is from Henrietta, Texas and plans to pursue graduate study in history.

Cowley lettered three years as a guard on the Bison Basketball team, starting some games as a freshman. Upon advice of his orthopedic surgeon he did not play basketball his senior year because of a defect in the cartilage of his knees that caused him to experience severe pain during and after participating in a game.
