Sharon Coleman of Harding University is the winner of the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference 1989 Downing-Swift-Wallace Scholar-Athlete Award.

Coleman, a three-year letterman on the Lady Bison track and field team, graduated *summa cum laude* in May with a Bachelor of Business Administration degree in management. She achieved a perfect 4.00 grade point average on 130 hours of college work.

1990 RECIPIENT

Jon Murray of Harding University is the winner of the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference 1990 Cliff Shaw Scholar-Athlete Award.

Murray, a four-year letterman on the Bison cross country and track and field teams, graduated *magna cum laude* in May with a Bachelor of Business Administration degree in management. He achieved a 3.79 grade point average on 135 hours of college work.

A member of Alpha Chi National College Honor Society and Who's Who Among Students in American Colleges and Universities, Murray received the senior management award for his work in the classroom. For his athletic endeavors, he earned NAIA All-American honors in indoor and outdoor track, and was a four-time All-AIC/NAIA District 17 selection in cross country, and three-time All-AIC runner in track and field. Murray captured the AIC/District 17 cross country title in 1988 and 1989, leading the Bisons to the team title.

Murray won the 10,000 meter run his junior year at the AIC Outdoor Track and Field Championship. In 1990, he became the first runner ever to win the 10,000 meter, 5,000 meter and 1,500 meter runs in the same AIC championship meet. He holds the AIC record in the 10,000 meter run, with a time of 31:03.3. He also owns Harding records in the outdoor marathon, 10,000 meters and 5,000 meters, and the indoor two-mile run.

At the 1990 NAIA Outdoor Track and Field Championship in Stephenville, Texas, Murray won the marathon event with a time of 2:3:22. He finished third in the event in 1989.

He was a member of the Society for the Advancement of Management, American Studies and the Barristers Pre-Law Club. He participated in summer Christian campaigns to Australia and Scotland.

Murray capped off his collegiate career by being named the winner of the first-ever Baldor Scholar-Athlete Award for men's cross country, indoor track and field and outdoor track and field.

He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Jim Murray of Diamond, Mo. A 1986 graduate of Carthage, Mo. High School, Murray ranked as one of Missouri's top middle distance runners. He served as president of Students Against Drunk Driving, was a member of the debate team and the student council, and graduated in the top six percent of his class.
