Helen Jones of Southern Arkansas University is the winner of the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference 1991 Downing-Swift-Wallace Scholar-Athlete Award.

Jones, a two-year letterman on the Riderette volleyball team, graduated in May with a Bachelor of Business Administration degree in finance. She achieved a 3.76 grade point average on all college work pursued.
